SPRINKLER BLOWOUTS October 27

Sprinkler blowouts will be made available to all residents on October 27.

Cost is \$33 per household.

Now is the time to start thinking about winterizing your home. The irrigation water is scheduled to be shut off in early October – approximately October 8. You can then start irrigation blowouts. Consider closing crawl space vents when you turn on your heating system. Read up on the various tax credits made available as part of the American Recovery and Reinvestment Act (stimulus bill). Some investments in energy savings made this year will earn fairly significant tax credits.

LANDSCAPE THANKS

Did you notice the nice protective covering and mount for the irrigation controls in the commons? Thank you to Mick Schraufnagel for the time and talent he donated to us all to design and build this cover. Since construction of our neighborhood, the irrigation controls were mounted on what looked like scrap lumber cobbled together. The original mount was unsightly and afforded no protection from the elements for these expensive controls. For a long time we have needed a more adequate mount/cover for these controls. The new one looks super and will last a long time. Thank you also to Morris Bastian and Lee Coulson who also helped dig, set footings, and mount the cover. This will go a long way to extend the life of the control boxes, and enhance the appearance of the picnic area in the center of the commons. Thank you Mick, Morris and Lee for your work on our behalf.

When you see Morris Bastian, please thank him for all that he does for our neighborhood. Once again Morris helped us avoid well over \$2500 in sprinkler repair and maintenance costs alone. He patrols our property daily, cleaning up, spraying weeds, maintaining flowers, and keeping an eye on things for us. Again this year he ran the Tuesday evening games for our children in the commons. This ever popular event is a big hit with the kids. It also becomes a forum for parents to meet mingle and get to know one another. Morris is a big factor in making our neighborhood as nice as it is. This summer the entrance sign to our neighborhood was destroyed by a car early one Saturday morning.
