# 2011 ANNUAL OWNERS MEETING MINUTES

April 21, 2011

Introduction: President Brian Edgar called the meeting to order at 7:05. He established that Notice had been accomplished in the required time. 21 memberships were represented, exceeding the quorum requirement of 15.

Brian introduced the directors of the Board who were present, Bruce MacMahon, Lee Coulson, Mark Jaszkowski, and Esther Williams, as well as Events Chair Dee Burlile.

**Minutes:** Motion to approve the Minutes of the 2010 Annual Owners Meeting (motion by M. Bastian; second from the floor; passed).

Landscape and Grounds: Landscape and Grounds Chair Mark Jaszkowski reported. Muir Woods is in the third year of a three year contract with Progressive Landscape which is doing an excellent job. He indicated that the odd weather year had an impact on the grounds. He thanked Morris Bastian for the help he gives by walking around and reporting on areas of concern or making repairs.

Mark Indicated that most of the major improvements that were left for the association to take care of have been accomplished and most work now is maintenance. He indicated that he saves a significant portion of funds until late in the landscape year to be certain that there will be funds for necessary expenses; optional improvements can then be accomplished as there are funds available.

Mark asked if anyone has opinions about PermaBark as opposed to bark in the land-scape areas. Some owners agreed that bark might be appropriate where children are not often playing. Some owners indicated that their experience has been that you get more weeds with PermaBark.

**Events:** Events Chair Dee Burlile requested more volunteers for the Easter Egg Hunt. She

indicated that 85-90 children had been signed up and more were expected.

The Muir Woods Yard Sale will be Saturday, June 18, 8:00-2:00. She indicated that in 2010 Randee and Andy Jackson had donated a large Muir Woods Garage Sale sign which will be used again for 2011.

4<sup>th</sup> of July BBQ is planned again for 2011. Dee asked for opinions regarding whether it might suit owners better to plan a picnic when there was not a family holiday taking people away from home. Most owners agreed that they prefer keeping the summer picnic on the 4<sup>th</sup> of July.

Motion to keep the Muir Woods BBQ on the 4<sup>th</sup> of July (motion by M. Bastian; second from the floor; passed).

Morris Bastian is willing to organize Tuesday Activity Night this summer.

**Web-site:** Lee Coulson reported that the web-page only costs the association a few \$'s per month. Some owners indicated they would like to have a closed Facebook for Muir Woods. Another indicated that an annual calendar would be helpful.

**Financial:** Treasurer Bruce MacMahon reported.

- Collection of assessments was at 96% for 2010, up 1% over 2009.
- Administration was under budget due in large part due to being under budget in 'delinquent account collection' and 'legal'.
- · Grounds costs were a little over budget.
- A Water Contingency line item for \$2200 was put in the 2011 budget and will be carried over each year for buying City water when the irrigation is turned off early.
- Net Income after transferring \$6000 to Reserve was \$5444.

Board Recommendation is to reduce the 3<sup>rd</sup> quarter dues by \$40 (to \$80) and use the net income of \$5444 from 2010 to make up any resulting shortfall; and it further recommended that members be informed that if anyone chooses to pay the full \$120 for the 3<sup>rd</sup> quarter, the excess \$40 will be added to the Events budget unless instructed otherwise by the owner.

Motion to accept the Board Recommendation as presented (motion by B. Hines; second by M. Bastian; passed).

Treasurer MacMahon went on to explain that the Muir Woods board turns over seriously delinquent accounts to an attorney that goes through a series of collections actions including Summary Judgment, Suit, Debtor's Exam, etc.

The Reserve account is currently at \$67,551; the long range plan was to have the Reserve Fund at \$76,800 at this time. The planned \$6000 per year contribution has been made but the interest on the funds has been very low since the economic downturn. The Board is not concerned with the lesser savings as it appears that some of the planned expenses from the Reserve can be put off a year or more when the scheduled time comes. The association is in very good financial condition.

Motion to accept the Financials as presented (motion by A. Brown; second by A. Jackson; passed).

#### **Owner Concerns:**

- Traffic Circle: Some owners are concerned about the appearance of the traffic circle and its interference with parking. Board is certain that any action taken will be at the association's expense. President Brian Edgar indicated that the Board would be happy to hear any concepts that are presented and encouraged owners most affected by the traffic circle to explore solutions. There are some funds in the Special Projects funds that might be available.
- Dogs are required to be on leash at all times in the common area.

**Election of Directors:** Nominations Chair Morris Bastian introduced the candidates. There were not nominations from the floor. The following were elected:

# GOOD NEWS ON HOA DUES 3rd Quarter decrease

Please take time to read the Muir Woods Annual Meeting Minutes. The association is in good financial condition. It is keeping on track with current maintenance needs while still contributing to the Reserve Funds on schedule. The Muir Woods HOA Board recommended that the 3rd Quarter HOA assessment be decreased by \$40 — taking that guarter only down to \$80.

When you send in your 3rd Quarter dues payment, remember to reduce it to \$80. If anyone pays the usual full \$120, the Board will apply the additional \$40 to be used for Events. This was voted on at the Annual Meeting, because some owners indicated that it is not worth the time it takes to change bank automatic withdrawals for one payment and were happy to be able to provide extra funds for building a great neighborhood.

Remember, for your 3rd Quarter dues, only \$80 is required.
