ACC submittal forms shall include the following and all materials submitted on 11"x17" reductions:

- 1. Site plan showing lot boundary, location of improvements, driveways, sidewalks, fences, outdoor lighting, and landscaping design. (One extra copy)
- 2. Floor plans with square footage measurements for all levels.
- 3. Elevations showing front, side and rear views. Also detailing exterior finish materials.
- 4. Specification sheet describing the materials and finishes proposed for interior and exterior.
- 5. Landscape plan showing proposed landscape layout, including legend of plant types and sizes.
- 6. Color chips or brochures showing all exterior finish materials, including paint, stone, brick and stucco finishes.
- 7. Contractor qualifications as requested.
