MWHOA CC&R Article V Section 5.10 Signs

The Muir Woods CC&R reads as follows:

"Section 5.10 Signs: No commercial billboard or advertising shall be displayed to the public view on or from any Lot. Owners may advertise a dwelling unit and Lot for sale by displaying a single, neat and reasonably sized sign on a Lot. Other temporary signs advertising the name of the builder or the name of the institution providing financing may be displayed on a Lot <u>during the construction of improvements</u>. All lighted, moving or flashing signs for any purpose are prohibited."

For temporary political or No Trespassing signs, the MWHOA Board will follow City of Boise ordinance Chapter 11.010-03: General Sign Regulations as the guideline for determining compliance with CC&R Article V Section 5.10. (http://www.cityofboise.org/city_clerk/072710/o-15-10.pdf)

Under the City of Boise General Sign Regulation, "political signs shall be allowed in all zoning districts without permit. Such signs shall not be placed in any public right-of-way and may not obstruct traffic visibility".

Under the City of Boise General Sign Regulation, "No Trespassing" or "No Dumping" or similar signs not to exceed one and one-half square feet in area and not exceeding four per parcel are allowed without permit. Such signs shall not be placed in any public right-of-way and may not obstruct traffic visibility.
